- 1. The eligibility criteria apply to both applicants. If one of the principal applicants from either country does not meet all the eligibility requirements, the proposal will not be processed.
- 2. Each proposal must include two principal applicants; one based in the UK and one in Israel. One of the applicants must serve as the primary applicant who will submit the application online. The other applicant is considered the partner applicant. Both are considered principal applicants.
- 3. The British and the Israeli principal applicants will act as co-holders of the grant. However, the application is submitted only once by the primary applicant.
- 4. Principal applicants and associated researchers must hold a position in research or academic institutions in the UK or Israel that are officially recognised by both countries¹.
- 5. The primary applicant must be based at a UK or Israeli university, or an academic or research institution that will receive the funding, the partner applicant can be based either at an academic institution in Israel or the UK, a not-for-profit organisation (including NGOs and organisations supported by government funding) or a for-profit or commercial organisation (e.g., SMEs and startups).
- 6. Institutions may submit multiple applications; however, individual applicants may submit only one application.
- 7. Third-country collaborations are welcome, but Wohl Clean Growth Alliance Grants can only cover costs related to UK or Israeli partners.
- 8. Current Wohl Clean Growth Alliance grantees with active projects at the time of the call deadline are not eligible to apply. They may be included in proposals **but not as principal applicants**.
- 9. Former grantees whose projects have concluded by the deadline are eligible to apply as principal applicants.
- 10. New partnerships are strongly encouraged. Existing partnerships that have previously received Wohl Clean Growth Alliance funding may also be considered in exceptional cases.
- 11. Partnerships between academic and industry partners are encouraged.
